**SUBJECT: 2017 ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (ATP) FINAL
REGIONAL PROGRAM RECOMMENDATIONS**

ISSUE

This Report serves to inform the Board of the final 2017 ATP Regional Program recommendations from the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG). At the January 18, 2017 Planning and Programming Committee meeting, Metro staff identified the SCAG 2017 ATP Regional Program Implementation Projects List for Los Angeles County. That list was adopted by the full Board on January 26, 2017. The Implementation Project List is one of three SCAG ATP components. As a reminder, there are two other components of the Regional Program under the purview of SCAG, the Planning and Non-infrastructure elements. This Board Box outlines the recommendations for those two elements.

DISCUSSION

The SCAG ATP Planning and Non-infrastructure awards totaling \$1,442,000 are the final 2017 ATP funding component and complete the SCAG ATP funding for Los Angeles County as presented to the Metro Board in item #14. The final added projects recommended for funding are shown in the table below.
