SUBJECT: ONE-YEAR EXTENSION TO CITY OF INGLEWOOD 3%
CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

ISSUE

In August 2016, the Board approved an agreement regarding the City of Inglewood ("City") 3% Contribution to the Crenshaw Line ("Agreement"). The City is requesting a one-year extension to the Agreement. Staff supports this extension. If there are no Metro Board comments by August 31, 2017, staff will administratively approve the extension to the Agreement.

DISCUSSION

The Agreement was approved by the Board in August 2016 and provided, in part, that the City would complete \$6 million of First / Last Mile improvements that serve Inglewood Metro Rail stations within 6 years of the Agreement's approval by the Board. The improvements would be identified through a Metro-led planning study, in cooperation with the City.

Metro resource constraints have slowed the initiation of that planning study. The request for proposals for the study has only recently been released. Responses are due August 23. Whereas the Agreement provided that the 6-year clock would start with Board approval, it was anticipated that the planning study would be initiated early in the first year. Given the delay, the City has requested a one-year extension to the Agreement so that they will have the full 6 years to both have the study completed and complete the work. Staff is supportive of the City's request.

NEXT STEPS

Staff will administratively approve the one-year extension if there are no Metro Board comments received by August 31, 2017.
