BOARD REQUESTED MONTHLY UPDATE ON CONTRACT

MODIFICATIONS FOR METRO GOLD LINE EASTSIDE

EXTENSION CONTRACTS - PERIOD ENDING FEBRUARY 2007

ISSUE

The Board of Directors has requested a monthly update report for construction contracts showing all executed and pending Contract Modifications and remaining Contract Modification authority value. The Contract Modification Report in Attachment A reflects the status of the Design/Bid/Build and Design/Build contract with Eastside LRT Constructors for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Project, as of the end of February 2007.

RATIONALE

On April 15, 2004, the Board of Directors reaffirmed the Chief Executive Officer's authority to execute Contract C0803 to the lowest-priced responsive and responsible bidder. The Board also authorized the Chief Executive Officer to execute contract modifications for Contract C0803 up to \$42,031,430, subject to reporting requirements and Board approved contract dollar limitations. On June 1, 2004, the contract was awarded to Eastside LRT Constructors (a joint venture of Washington Group International, Obayashi Corporation and Shimmick Construction Corporation) in the amount of \$600,449,000.

STATUS

During the month of February 2007, there were nine new Contract Modifications and one executed Change Order (Not-to-Exceed).

However, final negotiated values tend to end up in between the confidential Independent Cost Estimate and the Contractor's proposal. Not all pending change notices noted above become executed contract modifications – some are subsequently cancelled.
