**SUBJECT: CALL FOR PROJECTS GRANTS SUBJECT TO LAPSE
ON JUNE 30, 2012**

ISSUE

The Board adopted a Timely Use of Funds Policy and a Lapsing Policy for the Call for Projects. These policies require that sponsors receiving Call for Projects grants execute agreements within six months of Board recertification and obligate, allocate or expend their dollars within a three year period. This report provides the list of projects that are out of compliance with these adopted policies and whose funds are subject to lapse on June 30, 2012.

BACKGROUND

Every July, the Board recertifies fiscal year funding for projects programmed through the Call for Projects. For projects funded with Proposition C local sales tax dollars, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) must be executed by December 31st. For sponsors whose projects are funded with Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds or State Transportation Improvement Program Transportation Enhancement (STIP-TE) funds, a Letter of Agreement (LOA) must be executed by this same deadline. For projects that received a time extension, we require that an Amendment be executed by November 30th.

As of March 30, 2012, there are eight projects without an executed MOU, LOA or Amendment. Attachment A contains the list of the projects.

Also on an annual basis, we review the status of each project whose funds are subject to lapse at the end of the fiscal year. For those projects whose federal, state or local funds are not obligated, allocated, or expended, respectively, sponsors are notified that their projects may be subject to deobligation and are encouraged to expedite project delivery.

As of March 30, 2012, there are 100 potential projects with programmed funds that are subject to lapse on June 30, 2012. Attachment B contains the list of the projects. We are contacting these sponsors concerning their upcoming lapse date. We anticipate that as the Deobligation process continues, some projects may be removed from the list for the following reasons:

1. Project delay due to an unforeseen and extraordinary circumstance beyond the control of project sponsor (federal or state delay, legal challenge, act of god, etc.);
2. Project delay due to our action that results in a change in project scope, schedule or sponsorship that is mutually agreed upon prior to the extension request; and
3. Project is contractually obligated, however, a time extension is needed to complete construction that is already underway (capital projects only).

Community Redevelopment Agencies (CRA)

Attachment C lists seven additional projects that were granted time extensions, but have not executed an amendment, and seven projects that are subject to lapse on June 30, 2012. These projects are on hold because they were either awarded to Community Redevelopment Agencies (CRAs) [which no longer has authority to execute agreements] or local agencies who have proposed to use redevelopment funds as their local match. A letter was sent to all affected sponsors on March 22, 2012 which requested reconfirmation of their commitment to the project and their identification of alternative non-CRA funds as the new local match. Initially, we required a response by April 20, 2012. Based on numerous requests, we extended the deadline to May 21, 2012. We will continue to work with these project sponsors and keep the Board apprised as this effort progresses.

NEXT STEPS

For those project sponsors who continue to be out of compliance with the adopted Timely Use of Funds Policy and Lapsing Policy, sponsors will be given an opportunity to appeal the proposed deobligation of funds to our Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) in June 2012. TAC will then make a recommendation to staff on whether the project should be deobligated. Projects subject to deobligation will be brought to the Board for consideration in July 2012.
