Subject	Appointment of Dan Levy Executive Officer, CRCP

I am pleased to announce the appointment of Dan Levy to the position of Executive Officer, Civil Rights Compliance Programs. This appointment is consistent with a finding of the recently completed FTA triennial audit, which noted that the Equal Employment Opportunity unit should be elevated to Executive Officer level and should report directly to the Chief Executive Officer.

Dan is eminently qualified for this position. He has more than 30 years of transit experience in the U.S., Canada and internationally. This includes extensive work with ADA, EEO, Paratransit and Title VI issues with the San Diego Association of Governments, other transit agencies and consulting firms. Shortly after Dan arrived at Metro, the results of an FTA Civil Rights Review were released identifying significant shortcomings in our Title VI programs. Dan worked closely with the FTA for two years resulting in the findings being dismissed without any penalties or sanctions. Since arriving at Metro, Dan has also been involved in implementing the terms of the Gaddy lawsuit concerning the transportation of persons with disabilities and ensuring that our vehicles and stations meet or exceed the minimum ADA requirements.
