I am pleased to announce the appointment of three General Managers that will serve the San Gabriel Valley, San Fernando Valley and Gateway or South Bay Service Sectors. The three Service Sector General Managers are Jack Gabig, David Armijo and Richard Rogers.

Jack Gabig has served as General Manager of Montebello Bus Lines for the past twelve years, supervising 200 employees and overseeing a 75-vehicle bus and paratransit service.

Mr. Gabig's previous work experience includes Director of Maintenance and Director of Planning and Marketing for Long Beach Transit. He obtained a Bachelors of Arts Degree in Economics and a Masters Degree in Urban Planning from the University of Texas at Austin.

Mr. Gabig's major accomplishments at Montebello Bus Lines include the implementation of effective cost controls and a strong maintenance program, a successful public arts program, and construction of a regional rail station and transit center.

David J. Armijo has served as Director of Operations for the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) for the past six years, managing the Authority's bus and paratransit services, Metrolink commuter rail services and the Orange County Taxi Administration Program.

Mr. Armijo's previous work experience includes Director of Transportation, Transit and Aviation Director and Director of Contract Transit Services. Mr. Armijo obtained a Bachelors Degree in Public Administration from California State University, San Diego and a Masters Degree in Public Administration from California State University, Long Beach.

Mr. Armijo's major accomplishments at OCTA include increasing ridership by 40%, a 100% increase in commuter rail ridership, start-up of a 232 vehicle LNG fleet, and design and implementation of a \$14 million computerized radio dispatch communication system with satellite automated vehicle location.

Richard J. Rogers serves as Vice President of Transportation Concepts, managing all transit, shuttle, and paratransit contracts for the organization.

Mr. Rogers' over 21 years of transportation experience has included such positions as General Manager, Division Manager, Project Manager, and Operations Manager. Mr. Rogers will obtain a Bachelors of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of Redlands in May of this year.

Mr. Rogers' major accomplishments include a 400% business growth while enhancing service quality, development and implementation of management leadership training programs, and improved productivity through the restructuring of transit operations.
