The Notice of Intent to Award to recommended FSP awardees has been issued. Board Members may receive calls or inquiries on the subject procurement.

BACKGROUND

The following bidders are recommended for contract award.

Bids were also received from the following six contractors: All Star Towing, Best Car Towing, Classic Tow, Hadley Towing, Tow Masters and US Towing.

Two Bidders were disqualified, All Star Towing, Inc. and Best Car Towing. All Star Towing, Inc. was determined to be non-responsive and non-responsible as a result of failing to provide proof of current and valid Motor Carrier Permit (MCP). Best Car Towing was non-responsible for failing to provide proof of vehicle registration for the required time period (a period of twelve (12) months prior to bid due date) for a minimum of three (3) sling/wheel-lift style tow trucks.
