- Today SB 1152 (Polanco), the bill regarding the composition of the MTA Board, was amended to include provisions shared with you last week. The most significant amendment to SB 1152, splitting the selection of the four City of Los Angeles representatives on the board between the Mayor and the Council, was further amended to reflect that the two council representatives would be selected by the President of the Council. The bill now is back on "third reading," but at the bottom of the list of bills to be heard for vote on the Assembly floor. Word is that the Assembly is moving very slowly through its file, so
- SB 1152 may be considered for a final vote on Wednesday or Thursday of this week.
- There is no word on SB 1505, though the bill may be amended, again, tomorrow. A final vote on the measure could occur sometime this week.
- At this writing, the Conference Committee on SB 160 had not yet met today. Staff will continue to keep you informed on this issue.
