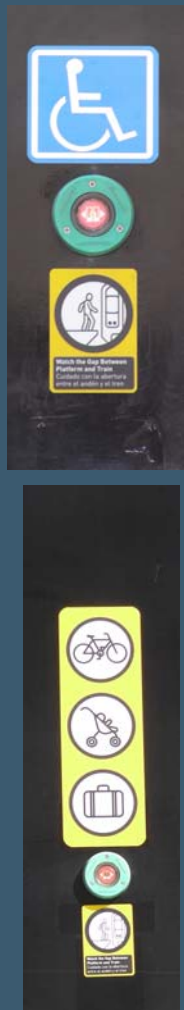


# Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension

- Wednesday, March 11 – Overhead Contact System (OCS) energized from First/Lorena to Pomona/Atlantic
  - Light Rail Vehicle ran under power for the first time
- OCS energized Monday-Friday, March 11-20 from 6:00am – 6:00pm. Train testing ongoing.
- Thursday, March 19 – Emergency Drill #1 will take place at 3<sup>rd</sup> and Downey (Auto vs. Train)

# Eastside Extension – Train Schedule

- Pre-revenue testing schedule has been completed
- Weekdays
  - 7.5-minute peak / 2-car trains
  - 12-minute mid-day / 2-car trains
  - 20-minute nights / 1-car trains
- Weekend
  - 15-minute mornings / 2-car trains
  - 12-minute mid-day and afternoons / 2-car trains
  - 20-minute nights / 1-car trains
- During pre-revenue testing, all trains will run from Sierra Madre Villa to Atlantic – revenue service from Sierra Madre Villa to Union Station; non-revenue testing mode (no passengers) from Union Station to Atlantic



# Eastside Extension – Train Operator Staffing

- A total of 23 additional Train Operators will be added to Gold Line Operations by May
- New Train Operator training class completed March 13 – 12 graduates; another class to be started last week of March
- Train Operator (transfers from Blue, Green and Subway Lines) cross-training currently underway
- 10 Extra Train Operators (working in Bus Divisions) will be moved to Gold Line



# Metro Rail Construction-Replacement-Repair

- Switch Machine Replacement – Blue Line
- Long Beach Street Paving – Blue Line
- Grade Crossing Rehabilitation – Blue Line
- Exposition Tie-in Projects – Blue Line
- Exposition Storage & Inspection Facility – Blue Line
- Traction Substation Replacement – Blue Line
- Pasadena Lake Ave. Improvements – Gold Line
- Grade Crossing Rehabilitation
  - Imperial to Florence
  - Washington and Florence





# Exposition Line / Blue Line Tie-in Update

Blue Line to be affected from Vernon Ave. to 7<sup>th</sup>/St. Metro Center. Major tasks include:

- Junction at Washington Bl. & Flower St.
- Crossover on Flower St., between Pico & Venice Bls.
- Crossover on Washington Bl., between Maple Ave. & Trinity St.
- Re-laying of track between 12<sup>th</sup> St and Griffith Ave.
- Overhead Contact System changes to support trackwork
- New Train Control equipment between 12th St and Griffith Ave.

Individual task dates to be determined – construction plan and timeline proposals continuing to be developed by Expo Construction Authority and their primary contractor.

# Expo Line Storage & Inspection Facility Update

Blue Line to be affected from Vernon Ave. to 7<sup>th</sup>/St. Metro Center. Major tasks include:

- 12 Car Storage & Insp. Facility at Washington Bl. / Long Beach Ave.
  - Crossover on Washington Bl., between Hooper St. & Long Beach Ave.
  - Crossover south of Washington Bl. & Long Beach Ave.
  - Crossover relocation south of 20<sup>th</sup> St.
  - Re-laying of track between Griffith Ave and Long Beach Ave.
  - Overhead Contact System changes to support trackwork
  - Train Control upgrades between Griffith Ave. and 41<sup>st</sup> St.

Project dates to be determined – Expo Construction Authority and their primary contractor are currently in the early design phase.
