CRENSHAW/SOUTH BAY TRANSIT CORRIDOR

MOTION BY DIRECTORS MARK RIDLEY-THOMAS, DON KNABE AND PAM O'CONNOR

Metro is in the process of preparing an Alternative Analysis (AA), Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS), in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) for the Crenshaw Transit Corridor, which extends approximately 10 miles from Wilshire Boulevard on the north to El Segundo Boulevard on the south.

The corridor study area includes five jurisdictions: the Cities of Los Angeles, Inglewood, Hawthorne, El Segundo, as well as portions of unincorporated County of Los Angeles. The area is generally defined as the area extending north to Wilshire Boulevard, east to Arlington Avenue, south to El Segundo Boulevard, and west to Sepulveda and La Tijera Boulevards.

As this project moves into the next stages of the planning process inclusion of the South Bay in the project title is a more accurate representation of the project area.

WE THEREFORE MOVE THAT:

The Crenshaw Transit Corridor be referred to as the "Crenshaw/South Bay Transit Corridor".
