### MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:40 a.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the March 25, 1995 meeting were approved.

3. BOS REVIEW OF CALL FOR PROJECTS

Staff updated the BOS on the schedule and process of the FY 1996 Call for Projects review. BOS requested that the Call for Projects package be mailed to BOS.

4. GREEN LINE BUS/RAIL FEEDER PLAN UPDATE

Staff gave an update on the status of funds for funding Green Line feeder plans. BOS requested staff to detail any specific plans they have to identify funds for this plan.

5. MTA OPERATING AND EFFICIENCY STUDY

Staff informed the BOS that there is a report produced by Operations. This report will be available at the next meeting. BOS also requested that the TPM standards be provided along with the operations report.

6. LONG RANGE PLAN UPDATE

MTA staff gave an update detailing the steps being taken in each functional area to arrive at some costs savings. The Cost Containment recommendation will be presented to the Board in June.

7. USE OF FY 1994-95 PROPOSITION C 40% DISCRETIONARY FUNDS

Staff distributed and explained a worksheet showing the projects funded from the 1994-95 Proposition C 40% Discretionary funds.

8. 1994-95 FARE REVENUE SHORTFALL MITIGATION PLAN

Staff described the Board report included in the Board agenda. The report noted a \$4 million loss in revenues in addition to the \$57 million shortfall due to the fare lawsuit and loss in ridership.

Staff further noted that Prop A interest has historically been allocated on a project basis rather than by formula.

BOS position was that if the interest funds are being allocated for operating subsidy then they should be allocated by formula.

Motion - BOS supports an allocation of any interest by formula and opposes if the allocation is to MTA operations.

9. COMMITTEE TO ADOPT PROP C SECURITY FUNDS ALLOCATION METHODOLOGY

Staff gave an update on the upcoming transit security committee meeting.

10. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Staff gave an update on SB 736 and SB 1152.

11. NEW BUSINESS

1. Stephanie from Santa Monica - SCAG will be selecting a consultant to work on IVHS technology for our region. She requested to include an update of this in the next meeting.
2. David Feinberg from Arcadia - he would be the representative for BOS on the CMP meeting the next day.
3. Kathryn Voltz from Montebello - BOS would like to see a coordinated marketing effort between MTA and the Municipal Operators.
