The Chairman announced that the purpose of the meeting was to consider adjustment of fares in order to provide adequate funds for the Authority's 1960 Budget.

The Executive Director recommended increases based upon an "Analysis of Fare Structures," attached to these Minutes as Exhibit A.

After discussion, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Authority has increased wages for contract employees designed to bring them to prevailing wage rates effective January 3, 1960; and

WHEREAS, there have been numerous substantial increases in the cost of other items required in providing transportation service to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is required under Section 1002 of the Trust Indenture to fix rates which shall at all times be adequate to pay its expenses and charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective 12:01 a.m., Sunday, January 24, 1960, the cash fares and token rates are established in the manner and in the amounts as set forth in Exhibit A attached to these Minutes.

There being no further business before the meeting, it adjourned.
