Morrison-Knudsen Corporation has met the MBE/WBE goals by utilizing the MBE/WBE subcontractors and suppliers shown in Attachment B.

The award will be for a total Contract amount of \$1,156,684

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Attachment "A" delineates how the cost and budget details of this award are allocated. A 10% Contract contingency to cover the cost of changes and extra work is recommended, but is not included in the Contract award amount. The Contract award amount represents approximately 84% of the Engineer's Estimate, and is considered fair and reasonable, based upon the analysis of competitively bid prices.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the RCC Board recommend that the MTA award Contract No. C0150 to Morrison-Knudsen Corporation, the lowest-priced responsive and responsible bidder. Award is contingent upon receipt of necessary bonds and proof of insurance, and resolution of any protest filed in a timely manner.

BACKGROUND:

The C0150 Contract Scope of Work comprises the following:

1. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) retrofit work at 11 stations on the Metro Blue Line not covered under Contract C6360 awarded on January 27, 1993. This retrofit work is as follows:
 - o Replacement of station platform edge warning strips.
 - o Installation of track crossing warning strips.
 - o Installation of accessible curb ramps, walks, and parking.
2. Replacement of deteriorated tile at ten Metro Blue Line Stations.

A California State Contractor's License Class "B" is required for this work.

The Invitation for Bids (IFB) was available on September 13, 1993. Two (2) addenda were issued, covering design changes and added work, and extending the bid opening date.

A Pre-Bid Conference was conducted on September 23, 1993.

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The following is a summary of each evaluated bid.

Morrison-Knudsen

The Low Responsible Bidder, Morrison-Knudsen submitted a bid that was deemed responsive. The company exceeded the MBE/WBE goals, proposing 21.8 and 13.5 percent respectively. The firm is a major contractor in both California and the rest of the United States, with a record of satisfactory performance on construction projects which are similar, both as to character and contract value, to the C0150 work scope, including projects for the MTA and Metrolink. Evidence of the required Class "B" license was furnished with the bid. The bidder's quality assurance program and industrial safety record also support its standing as a responsible bidder.

FTR International

The second responsible low bidder, FTR International submitted a bid that was deemed non responsive, as the bidder did not meet the WBE goal and did not submit satisfactory good faith efforts documentation.


Terra-Cal Construction

The third low responsible bidder, Terra-Cal Construction, submitted a bid that was deemed responsive. The company would meet the MBE/WBE goals. The firm has a history of satisfactory performance on construction projects which are similar, both as to character and contract value, to the Contract C0150 work scope, including projects for the MTA and Metrolink. Evidence of the required Class "B" license was obtained from the bidder. The bidder's quality assurance program and industrial safety record also support its standing as a responsible bidder.

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
