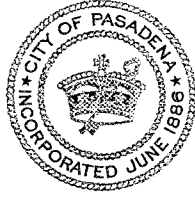
Thank you for your recent letter concerning the upcoming term expiration of our cluster's representative on the Governance Council for MTA's San Gabriel Valley Service Sector.
