Metrolink by the Numbers



- 144 weekday trains on 7 lines
- 55 stations across the Metrolink System
- Approximately 40,000 avg. weekday trips
- Operates on a 512-mile system
- Avg. train weighs 400 tons
- \$173.3 million operating budget

Improved Mobility to Burbank's Bob Hope Airport

- Existing trains 900 and 901 are extended to Burbank's Bob Hope Airport
- Train 301 from San Bernardino will depart earlier in order to connect to train 901 from Union Station arriving at the airport at 6 a.m.
- OC line train 681 from Laguna Niguel will also depart earlier to connect to train 901



Express Train Pilot Program

- Morning and afternoon express trains added to Antelope Valley and San Bernardino lines
- Limited stops = Time savings for passengers
 - 4 stops on each line
 - LA Union Station, Covina, Rancho Cucamonga and San Bernardino
 - LA Union Station, Downtown Burbank, Santa Clarita and Palmdale
- 1 hour saved every round-trip (5 hours a week, 20 hours a month)
- Adds value to current passengers and attracts new riders
- No increased fare for express service

More service, same great value

- Ventura County Line
 - Two additional trains between L.A. Union Station and Chatsworth
 - Various time changes to accommodate new service
- Antelope Valley Line
 - Four midday trains added (in addition to express trains)
 - Various time changes to accommodate new service
- San Bernardino Line
 - Four midday trains added (in addition to express trains)
 - Various time changes to accommodate new service



Corporate Pass Program

- Corporate Partners who purchase Metrolink tickets and provide them to their employees
- Responsible for over 25% of Metrolink's annual revenue
- Developing new sliding scale that will incentivize large purchases
- New account executives help service the corporate partners
