Link Union Station

Metro has initiated the environmental process for Link Union Station (Link US), formerly known as the Southern California Regional Interconnector Project (SCRIP). Metro will hold a Scoping Meeting to provide information on the project and receive comments from the public. Link US will extend the railroad tracks at Los Angeles Union Station (LAUS) over the US-101 freeway, provide one-seat rides from Ventura to Anaheim and San Bernardino to Los Angeles, and reduce dwell times to 5 minutes. Link US will allow LAUS to meet the forecasted demands of the regional rail system by increasing capacity by 40% and potentially accommodating California High-Speed Rail. Link US will also build a new expanded passenger concourse with retail amenities.

Metro Emergency Security Operations Center

Metro is designing a new Emergency Security Operations Center (ESOC) at 410 Center Street in the City of Los Angeles Arts District (southeast corner of Ducommun Street and Center Street) on property already owned by Metro. The new facility will serve as the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and central location for Metro security operations, radio dispatch, and emergency coordination. Metro is also planning to integrate Rail and Bus Operations Centers into the facility. This will be a secured facility for authorized personnel only.
