As you know, there are currently two vacancies on the San Fernando Valley Sector Governance Council formerly filled by Ms. Marsha Ramos from the City of Burbank and Ms. Nury Martinez from the City of San Fernando. These vacancies provide representation for the cities of Burbank, Glendale and San Fernando. In order to quickly restore full representation to this important oversight group, I respectfully request that Burbank Mayor Gary Bric be nominated to serve as a member of the Governance Council to represent transit riders in the three cities. This nomination has been discussed with officials from the City of Glendale, who agree that Gary is the appropriate person to help provide important oversight of local transit operations in the San Fernando Valley.
