SUBJECT: MONTHLY UPDATE ON THE TRANSIT POLICING CONTRACT PERFORMANCE

ACTION: RECEIVE AND FILE

RECOMMENDATION

Receive and file report the monthly update on the transit policing ~~contract~~ performance

ISSUE

On September 4, 2014, the board requested that staff provide a monthly update on transit policing performance to Systems Safety and Operations Committee. Specifically, the board requested monthly updates on criminal activity, fare enforcement, response time, deployment and perception of safety.

DISCUSSION

Staff is providing the following updates to each of the requested items:

Criminal Activity:

- Part 1 Crimes have decreased by 3.7% from January 2014 to August 2014 compared to January 2013 to August 2013 system-wide.
- Overall, buses had an increase of .25 Part 1 crimes per 1,000,000 riders from the same period last year (From 1.40 to 1.65)

Fare Enforcement:

- In August 2014, law enforcement performed 797,617 fare checks system wide, an increase of 4,915 fare checks compared to July 2014. Metro and LASD are implementing scheduled 100% fare checking strategy throughout the system.

Response Time:

- In August 2014, the average response time for “Calls for Service” (Emergency, Priority, and Routine) for all rail lines, including Silver Line is 19.1 minutes. LASD currently comply with Metro’s Performance Metrics requirement of average 30 minutes for call for service.

Deployment:

- LASD’s deployment is based on their Intelligence Lead Policing (ILP) strategy. From month to month, deputies are redeployed to specific Lines based on the ILP to ensure the safety of the patrons. Data obtained thru ILP strategy contains specific bus and rail data which assists law enforcement in the deployment of resources in order to ensure safety throughout the system.

Perception of Safety:

- LASD has proposed utilizing a Community Policing Survey which would assist in obtaining direct patron perception of safety. Attachment B is a sample which would be modified to be applicable for Metro transit patrons. Findings would be reported monthly.
- Metro will explore incorporating perception of safety questions into the Transit Watch application.

NEXT STEPS

Metro Security will continue working with Metro Strategic Initiatives department to enhance the ridership survey as well as explore additional methods in order to obtain more data regarding Metro ridership perception of safety. Metro will continue working with LASD to establish measurable perception of safety criteria through the Community Policing Survey and the Transit Watch application. Staff will provide monthly performance updates.



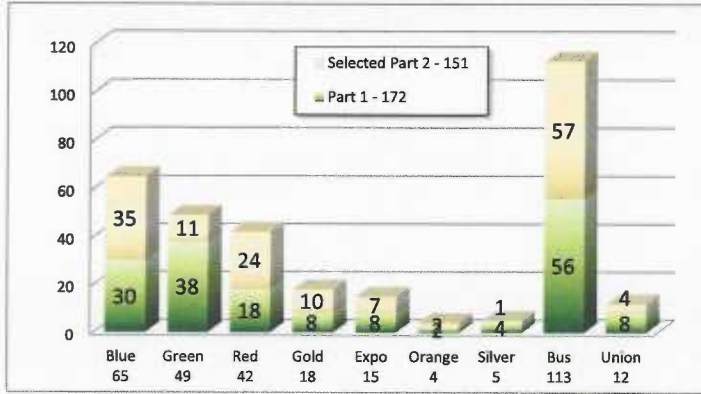
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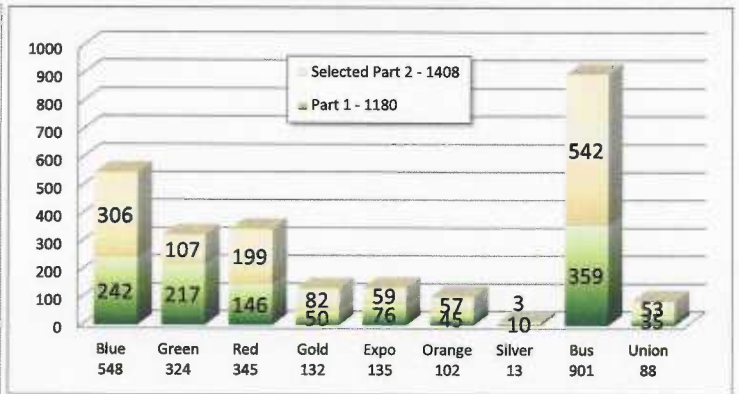

Aug Crimes - 323



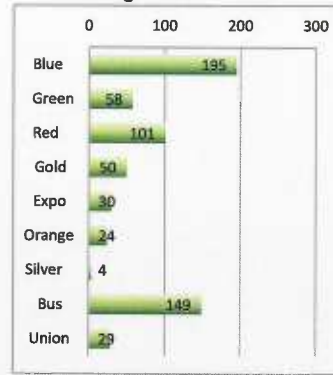
YTD Crimes - 2588



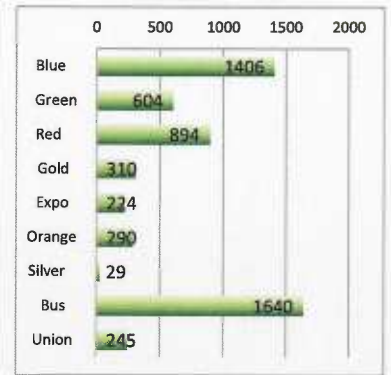

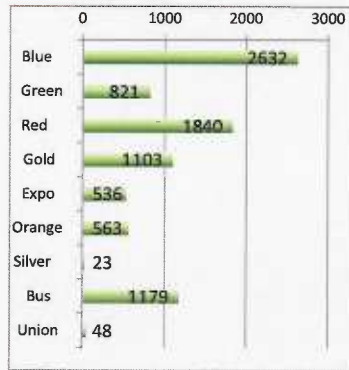
Aug Arrests - 640



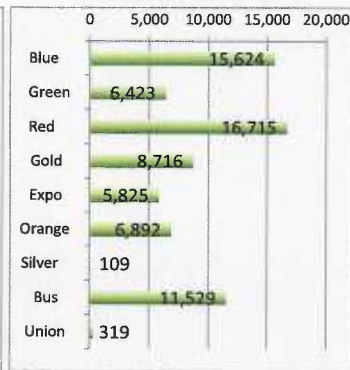
YTD Arrests - 5642



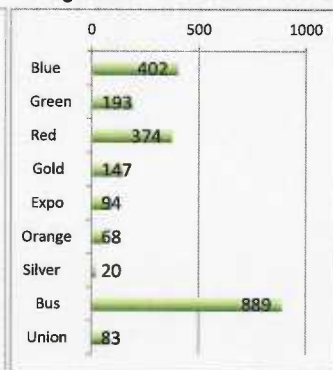
Aug Citations - 8745



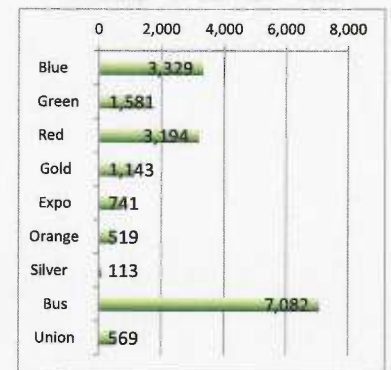
YTD Citations - 72152

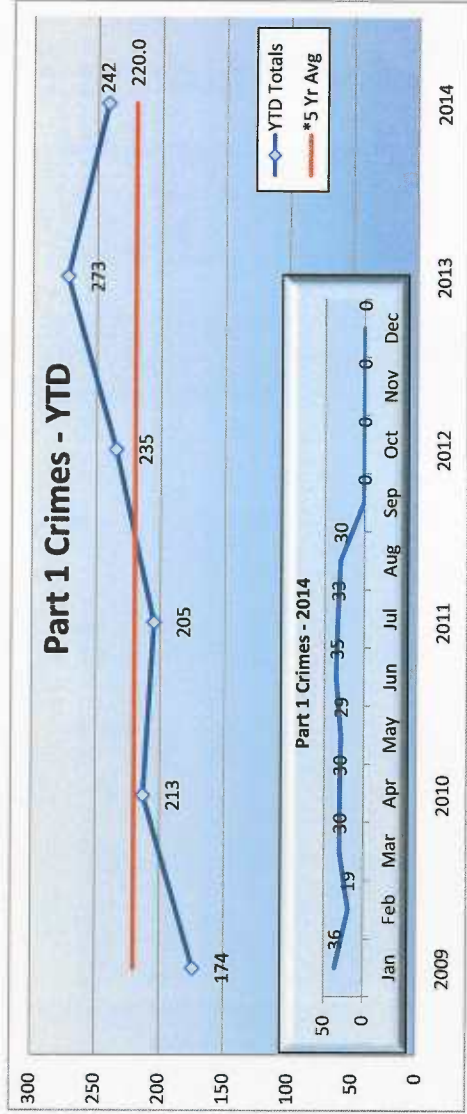

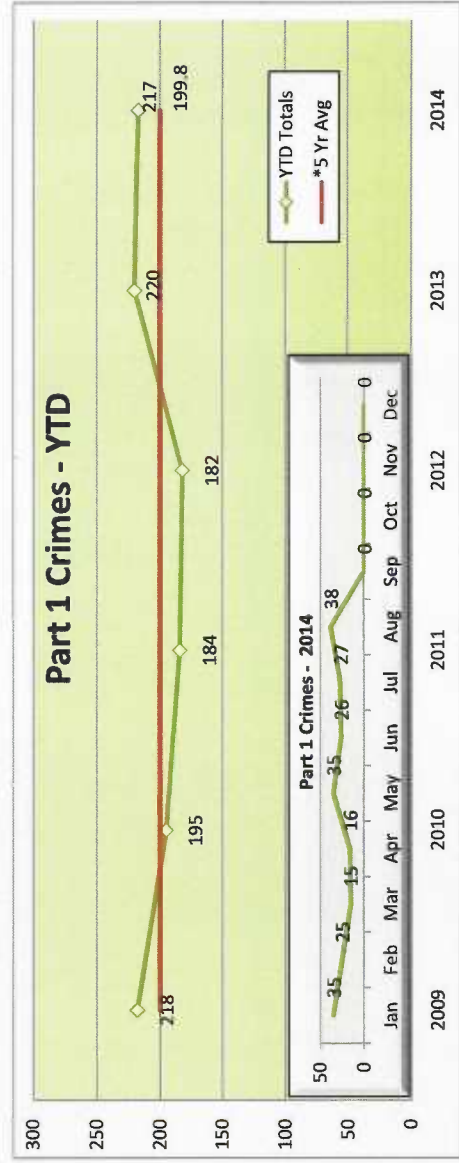
