**SUBJECT: MONTHLY UPDATE ON THE TRANSIT POLICING CONTRACT**

**ACTION: RECEIVE AND FILE**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Receive and file monthly update on the transit policing contract.

**ISSUE**

On April 17, 2014, the System Safety and Operations Committee requested staff to provide a monthly update on the transit policing contract.

**DISCUSSION**

Staff is providing the following updates on the transit policing contract:

Metro Staff is continuing to work with LASD to implement recommendations from the "Los Angeles Sheriff's Department Contract Audit Matrix Report" and the APTA peer review that are pertinent to the current contract.

Metro staff has developed a Transit Policing Statement of Work and, in conjunction with the Procurement Department, has developed a timeline for the acquisition plan for the new Transit Policing contract.

A special Board Meeting was held September 4, 2014 in which the Metro Board directed the CEO to respond to 8 items which will strengthen contract policing oversight, ensure adequate staffing, and establish clear and consistent communication regarding the Metro Security program as a whole.

Metro will be requesting to the board in November to authorize a six month extension to the current contract in order to:

1. Allow time to review the draft Statement of Work for the new RFP with the ad hoc committee of Board members (per motion by Mayor Garcetti, Supervisor Molina, Supervisor Antonovich, and Director Fasana).
2. Issue a Request for Proposal for the new Transit Policing Contract.

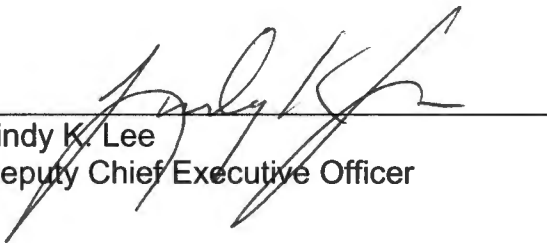
3. Review proposals and conduct interviews.
4. Present recommendation for award to Board.

### **NEXT STEPS**

Continue to work on implementing recommendations from the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department Contract Audit Matrix Report and APTA peer review that are pertinent to the current contract.

Continue to work on addressing the 8 items as directed by the Board motion. The resolution of these items will be presented to the System Safety, Security and Operations Committee on requested dates.
