ISSUE

This is to advise the Board that the Draft 2008 Long Range Transportation Plan (Plan) for Los Angeles County will be released to the public on Wednesday, March 12, 2008, and that staff is providing a press briefing on Tuesday, March 11, 2008. In anticipation of both events, you are being provided an advance copy of the Draft 2008 Plan.

DISCUSSION

The Draft 2008 Plan is consistent with the Board action on January 24, 2008 which approved recommendations for projects and programs in the funded Constrained Plan and a Two-Tiered unfunded Strategic Plan. The Plan also assesses future population and employment increases projected for the County and what such increases will mean for future mobility needs. It also recommends what can be done within forecasted revenues, as well as what could be done if additional revenues become available.

The Draft Plan will undergo a 45-day public review period and comments are due by Friday, April 25, 2008. Seven community meetings will be held throughout the County where staff will discuss the Plan and seek public comment (see attachment). Staff will also conduct outreach with each of the nine subregions. After the 45-day public review period, public comments will be reviewed and a final 2008 Plan will be developed for Board adoption in late June 2008.

NEXT STEPS

The Draft 2008 Plan for Los Angeles County will be released to the public on Wednesday, March 12, 2008.
