

SUBJECT: PROPOSED SALES TAX 2008 POPULATION DATA

ISSUE

Several Board members and several representatives from Councils of Government asked that we update the 2004 population and employment data that we previously used to estimate subregional equity for the proposed one-half cent sales tax expenditures. We are still working on updating employment data and expect to have that information early next week.

BACKGROUND OR DISCUSSION

Attachment A is a table showing 2008 population as estimated by the California Department of Finance along with percentages for each subregion of the total County population. The population in the unincorporated County was distributed to the subregions using the methodology that the County uses to distribute Proposition A and C local return. The City of Los Angeles population has been removed from all of the other subregions and shown as a total city population. The northern corridor cities have been grouped together at the request of their Board representative.

NEXT STEPS

Staff will incorporate this updated data in our subregional project comparison charts.
